WITHDRAWAL FROM THE CERTIFICATION

Students are not allowed to withdraw from the CERTIFICATION. If a student cannot continue the CERTIFICATION his/her fee will be forfeited.

EVALUATION AND GRADING

The performance of students is evaluated through continuous observation of a student's performance in the CERTIFICATION – class participation, submission of assignments, quizzes and exercises.

The student will be examined through three hourly exams conducted at the midterm and a final exam at the end of the program. Total marks for passing the CERTIFICATION will be 70 out of a total of 100.

Students who do not meet the attendance or any other eligibility criteria will not be allowed to appear in the final examination.

Students who are unable to appear for the final exam are required to submit a written application stating the reason for not appearing for the exam. 3D EDUCATORS reserve the right to approve or deny such applications. If approved, the student will be allowed to sit for the exam within one month. Failure to do so, the student will be resubmit the examination fee and sit the future schedule exam. Without passing of the exams no certification will be awarded.
